

Quilt Preparation

Quilt Top

1. Secure all seams.
2. Trim all threads
3. Square up the quilt top.
4. Carefully press quilt top.
5. Mark the top of the quilt with a safety pin.



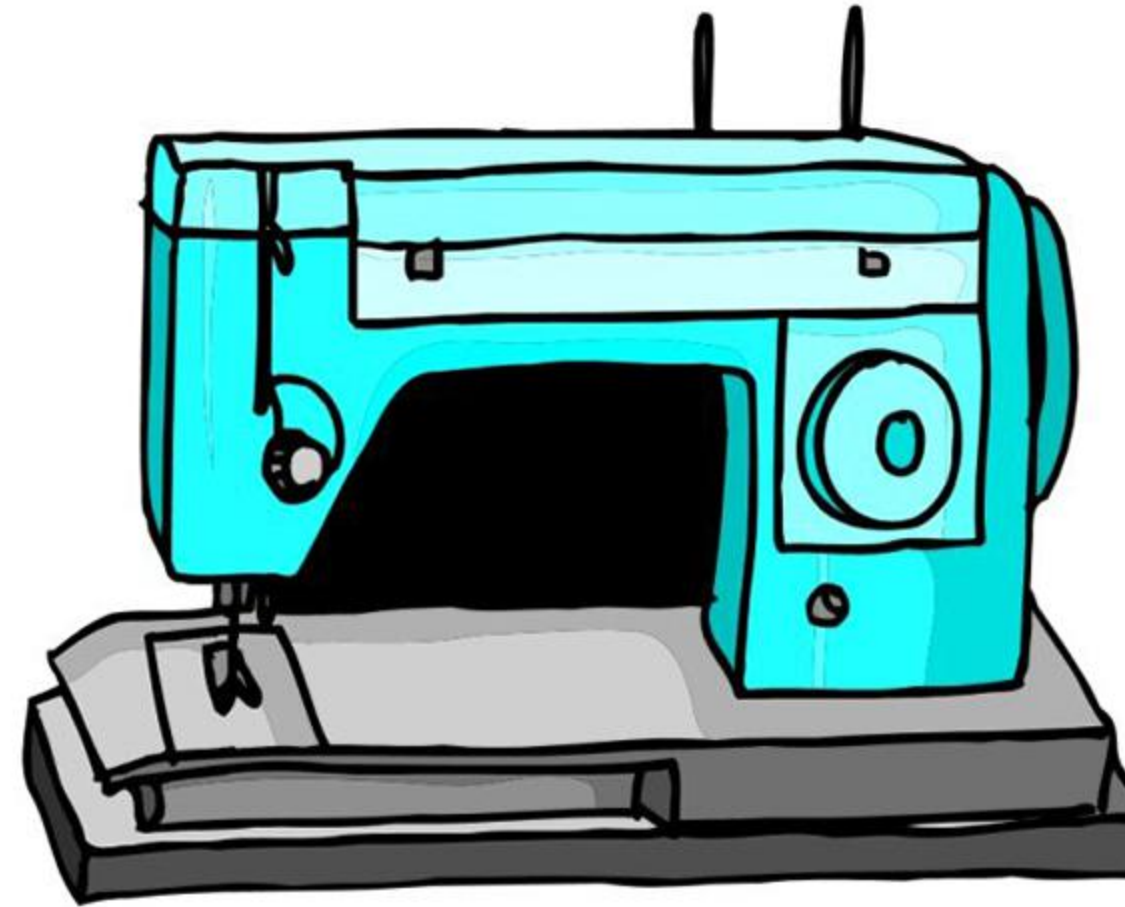
Quilt Back

1. Use a 1/2" seam allowance for all seams to piece your backing. Press all seams open.
2. Quilt back must be 8 inches larger than the length and width of your quilt top. For example: if your top measures 60" x 70" then your backing must measure 68" x 78".
3. Carefully press backing.

*Do not pin or baste your quilt together.

* Your quilt will be quilted in the condition that it was received. It will be as free of tucks and pleats as your piecing will allow.

Edge to Edge Patterns

Edge to edge patterns and all over pantograph patterns are priced by the square inch. For most patterns the price is .030 cents\per square inch.

Formula: width x length x .030 = cost of longarm quilting not including batting and taxes.



* We have a vast assortment of patterns to choose from and will be adding more in the future. If you have a special request, I will do my best to accommodate your request.

*For small and crib size quilts there is a \$50.00 minimum

* **Payment required upon delivery.**

Custom Quilting

Custom quilting includes all of the following:

- *Individual motifs
 - *Unique quilting specifically to fit within the piecing of your quilt
 - *Separate design for the borders for sashing
 - *Stitch in the ditch or cross hatching
- Custom quilting starts at .050 cents/ per square inch and up depending on the type of customizing requested.
- *We also offer grid basting for those who hand quilt

Grid basting: .020 cent/per square inch

Possible Additional Charges

\$15.00 to sew backing fabric.

\$20.00 per hour for quilt repairs, repairing seams, pressing and clipping threads.

\$35.00 Rush Charge (Sept.-Dec we do not accept rushes)

\$25.00 T-shirt quilts with pockets, buttons, and excessive thickness.

\$15.00 for Minky backs.

\$15.00 Center backings.

.05 cents per inch for grids, and any other hand guided E2E quilting.

\$25.00 additional fee for double sided quilts.
